Dance Attire & Shoes

Please see below for the required dance attire and shoes. Dancers are required to have shoes for ballet, tap, jazz, and hip hop classes. Dancers will wear jazz shoes for musical theater classes and be barefoot for lyrical, contemporary, and tumbling classes.

What to Bring

In addition to bringing your required dance shoes, please bring a snack and/or lunch for each day. All food should be in a closed container and labeled with your dancer's name on it. If needed, we have a refrigerator and microwave. Water bottles are encouraged, but we do have water fountains.



Studio and Summer Camp Policies

Summer Registration & Tuition Policies

1. There will be a \$25 one-time summer camp Registration Fee per child due at the time of registration. Registration Fees are non-refundable.
2. Summer Camp tuition fees are paid for in week increments. Elite Studios does not offer a daily or monthly rate.
3. Summer Camp tuition fees are refundable up to 24 hours prior to a camp's start date. Tuition fees are non-refundable after a camp has begun.
4. Any camp with will less than 5 students enrolled will be cancelled. Elite Studios will notify families if a camp is to be cancelled within 5 business days of that camp.
5. By registering for summer camp at Elite Studios, you are authorizing Elite Studios to automatically bill your credit card or bank account on file at the time that a payment is due.
6. Summer camp registrations will be processed 3 - 5 business days after receipt of online registration.
7. Families with 2 or more dancers will receive a 5% discount on tuition per additional child.

Studio Premises Policies

1. At any time, no student of Elite Studios may leave the studio alone and unattended by a parent and/or guardian.
2. At any time and for any reason, no student of Elite Studios may cross Hammond Drive and/or Roswell Road by walking alone and unattended by a parent and/or legal guardian.

Photography Release

1. By registering your child as a dancer at Elite Studios, you, hereby, grant Elite Studios and its owner and faculty permission to use photos and videos for any promotional purpose including, but not limited to, digital and print advertisements, social media content, website content, and other promotional collateral.

Medical Policies

1. Students and parents/guardians are responsible for making sure all medical conditions and allergies are fully described on the student's tab in the Parent Portal and kept up to date. This includes a description of any required emergency care medication or device (such as an "epi-pen," inhaler, etc.) which the student may need and specific instructions for when/under what circumstances the medication/device should be used, and how it should be used.
2. In addition, all students with an emergency medication/device must comply with the following requirements:
 - a. The medication/device must be placed in a closed plastic baggie clearly labeled with the student's name and easy to understand written instructions concerning when/under what circumstances the medication/device should be used, and how it should be used. The instructions in the baggie also must include the name and telephone number for two emergency medical contacts.
 - a. Students with a medication/device are required to bring the baggie to and from Elite Studios activities and, at all times while at Elite Studios, to keep the baggie in a gear bag on their person or, during classes, in the classroom.



3. Notwithstanding the above, by checking below, you acknowledge and understand that Elite Studios does not render medical care, including medical diagnosis or treatment, to students or others, and that any assistance that Elite Studios owner and/or faculty may offer to a student will be limited to responding to an emergency.

Release of Liability

1. As the legal parent or guardian, you, hereby, release and hold harmless Elite Studios and its owners and faculty from any and all liability, claims, demands, and causes of action whatsoever, arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by the participant and/or the undersigned, while in or upon the premises or any premises under the control and supervision of Elite Studios and its owners and faculty or in route to or from any of said premises. You recognize and understand that participation in Elite Studios programs may require strenuous activity and accept responsibility for any injuries sustained at Elite Studios.

Studio Policies

1. All dancers must abide by the dress code stated for each class. Dancers not following this dress code will be asked to sit out.
2. Dancers are not to leave clothes, food, drinks, etc. around the studio space. All items left in the lost & found for more than one month will be donated to Goodwill.
3. All students are expected to arrive to classes at least 10 minutes prior. Dancers arriving to class more than 15 minutes late will be asked to sit out. Elite Studios values lessons of discipline, responsibility, and time management and will enforce these teachings.
4. All dancers and other children must be behaved throughout the studio. Causing a disruption to ongoing education will result in a child being asked to leave the studio.
5. Dancers under the age of 8 must be accompanied by a parent if arriving more than 15 minutes early. Dancers under the age of 8 must be picked up by a parent no more than 15 minutes after a class ends.
6. Parents, siblings, and friends of dancers are not allowed in the studios while a class is going on. This causes a distraction to the dancer and the teacher and results in a lowered quality of education for each dancer. Elite Studios offers a parent viewing location in the lobby to watch your dancer's progress and learning on our TVs.
7. No dancer, at any time, is allowed to cross Hammond Drive or Roswell Road without adult supervision for any reason.
8. The Elite Studios staff is happy to meet with you at any time regarding your dancer's progress and education, however these meetings must be scheduled through the Director and Teacher directly, as teachers do not have time in between classes.
9. Private lessons will be offered by a range of Elite Studios staff. These must be scheduled through the Director and the Teacher directly. Private lessons will be offered to enrolled Elite Studios families only.
