

# COVID19 SAFETY PROCEDURES

All dancers and families must understand and observe these policies for the safety and well being of all Elite Studios students, families, and faculty. Elite Studios will continue to follow CDC guidelines for safety. Changes to any policies will be in accordance with any changes to CDC guidelines.



## ▶ GENERAL WELLNESS CHECK

- No one, i.e. dancers, faculty, parents, guardians, etc, is permitted to enter Elite Studios if they have been diagnosed or exhibiting symptoms that have been associated with the Covid19 virus such as, but not limited to, coughing, shortness of breath, fever of greater than 100.4, etc. OR come into contact with someone diagnosed or exhibiting these symptoms within the last 14 days.

## ▶ LOBBY POLICIES

- Beginning June 7, the Elite Studios lobby is reopened to parents and guardians with some new policies in place. New policies below are to eliminate unnecessary crowding.
- Seating in the parent lobby will be limited this season. In order to accommodate as many parents as possible, parents are asked to plan to watch a class every few weeks rather than every week.
- Once the seats in the Parent Lobby are filled, no more parents will be able to stay to watch a class (ie - no standing or sitting on the floor will be permitted)
- The area known as The Dancer's Space will be for the exclusive use of dancers; parents/guardians are kindly requested to avoid sitting in this area.
- The studio will open for each class 15 minutes prior to class start time - dancers are welcome to use the change rooms and restrooms upon arrival.
- Dancers and families are encouraged to leave as soon as possible after a class ends and avoid lingering so that the lobby is not overcrowded.

## ▶ ARRIVAL POLICIES

- Parents with dancers in the second grade and below are asked to park their cars and walk their dancers into the studio no earlier than 15 mins before their class is scheduled to begin.
- Dancers in the third grade and older may be dropped off at the door in the same manner as last season (driving around the parking lot and pulling up with the front passenger side of the car closest to the steps) .
- All visitors and dancers will be asked to use hand sanitizer provided at the entrance of Elite Studios.
- Dancers are encouraged to arrive already dressed in dance clothes whenever possible. Changing rooms and restrooms will be available for use as needed.

## ▶ DEPARTURE POLICIES

- Parents will be responsible for parking their cars and entering the studio to collect dancers who are in the second grade or below. We ask that families depart the studio as quickly as possible after a class so that the next group of dancers can get into the studio.
- Dancers in the third grade and older may depart the studio on their own to meet their parent either on the ramp outside of the front door or at their parent's vehicle. This decision is up to each family to make for their own dancer.

## ▶ IN-STUDIO POLICIES

- Beginning June 7, in accordance with the CDC guidelines, vaccinated people ages 12 & older are allowed to come in to the studio & participate without wearing a mask. We trust the close community of Elite Studios families to follow and abide by these guidelines to keep our dancers and their families safe.
- For all students who are ineligible to be vaccinated and adults who are yet to be vaccinated, in accordance with CDC guidelines, masks will be required in the studio at all times. This is for all students ages 11 & under.
- Increased ventilation and medical-grade air purifiers have been installed throughout the studio for quality air cleanliness.
- All dancers will be asked to use the hand sanitizer provided at each studio door upon every entrance and exit to the dance studio.
- Within the studio, physical social distancing will be maintained throughout.
- The space at the front of the room is marked off for the Faculty so that students and Faculty can maintain social distancing guidelines.
- For ballet barre use, dancers are assigned spots designated 3' apart.

## ▶ FACULTY POLICIES

- The Elite Studios faculty is strongly encouraged to get vaccinated for Covid-19.
- Those faculty that are not vaccinated due to a medical condition or religious restriction will continue to be required to wear masks while teaching.
- Elite Studios faculty are not permitted to enter Elite Studios to teach if they or someone within their family have exhibited symptoms or have been in contact with someone who has exhibited symptoms similar to those seen in the Covid19 virus in the last 14 days.

## ▶ BATHROOM POLICIES

- Only 1 person allowed In each bathroom stall at one time, and one at sink.
- No dancers or Faculty allowed to wait in the bathroom at any time.
- Bathrooms are closely monitored for no over crowding.
- Bathrooms are tidied throughout the day.
- Additional signage has been installed to promote consistent hand washing.
- Water fountains are closed until further notice. Elite Studios sells water bottles for \$1 at the Front Desk.

## ▶ CHANGING ROOM POLICIES

- Dancers are encouraged to arrive already dressed in dance clothes whenever possible. Changing rooms and restrooms will be available for use as needed.
- Only 1 dancer allowed in each changing stall at one time.
- No dancers allowed to wait in the changing room at any time.

## ▶ WHAT TO DO IF YOU HAVE A BRUSH WITH COVID-19

Follow this step by step guide for what to do if you have experienced a brush with Covid-19 and are curious how to handle dance class.

### I AM EXPERIENCING COVID-LIKE SYMPTOMS

#### STEP 1


- If you are exhibiting symptoms that have been associated with the Covid19 virus such as, but not limited to, coughing, shortness of breath, fever of greater than 100.4, etc. OR come into contact with someone exhibiting these symptoms within the last 14 days, please stay home from Elite Studios.

#### STEP 2

- Quarantine for a minimum of 48 hours whilst monitoring symptoms.
- Notify Elite Studios of illness to schedule a make-up or schedule Zoom participation.
- Get a Covid-19 test 48 - 72 hours after experiencing symptoms.

#### STEP 3

- If a Negative test result is found, dancer may return to dance at Elite Studios.
- If a Positive test result is found, notify Elite Studios immediately so that Elite Studios may begin contact tracing if necessary.
  - Dancer should begin 7-day quarantine from time of exposure.
  - Dancer may return to dance after their 7-day quarantine.

## I WAS EXPOSED TO A POTENTIAL COVID-19 CASE

### STEP 1

- If you were exposed to a potential Covid-19 case, please follow these steps.
- Note that exposed must be by definition a "close contact" as defined by the CDC as
  - Within 6 feet of someone who has COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more
  - You provided care at home to someone who is sick with COVID-19
  - You had direct physical contact with the person (hugged or kissed them)
  - You shared eating or drinking utensils.
  - They sneezed, coughed, or somehow got respiratory droplets on you.

### STEP 2

- Notify Elite Studios of the potential exposure immediately.
- Dancer should begin 7-day quarantine from time of exposure.
- Get a Covid-19 test 48 - 72 hours after exposure.
- Elite Studios will schedule a make-up or schedule Zoom participation if a competitive dancer.
- Siblings of exposed dancers should be adequately quarantined from the exposed dancer. In order for the sibling to return to dance, they must have a negative test result before returning.

### STEP 3


- If a Positive test result is found, notify Elite Studios immediately so that Elite Studios may begin contact tracing if necessary.
  - Dancer should begin 7-day quarantine from **time of test.**
  - Dancer may return to dance after their 14-day quarantine.
- If a negative test result is found, dancer must still maintain a 7-day quarantine and can return 7 days after date of exposure.

## I TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

### STEP 1



- Notify Elite Studios of the positive test result immediately.
- Dancer should begin 7-day quarantine from **time of test**.
- Siblings of dancers with confirmed positive cases should begin 7-day quarantine, as direct contact.

### STEP 2

- Elite Studios will schedule a make-up or schedule Zoom participation if a competitive dancer.

### STEP 3

- Dancer may return to dance after their 7-day quarantine.
- Sibling dancers of confirmed positive case may return to dance after their 7-day quarantine.

## MY SCHOOL WAS QUARANTINED FOR A COVID BRUSH

### STEP 1

- Notify Elite Studios of the quarantine immediately.
- Dancer should begin 14-day quarantine from time of quarantine from school.
- Elite Studios will schedule a make-up or schedule Zoom participation if a competitive dancer.

### STEP 2

- Dancer may return to dance after their 7-day quarantine.



## A SIBLING OR MEMBER OF HOUSEHOLD WAS QUARANTINED FOR A COVID BRUSH

### STEP 1

- Dancer should quarantine for a minimum of 48 hours whilst monitoring symptoms.
- Notify Elite Studios to schedule a make-up or schedule Zoom participation.
- Get a Covid-19 test 48 - 72 hours after experiencing symptoms.

### STEP 2

- Dancer should be adequately quarantined from the quarantined person in the household. In order to return to dance, potentially exposed/quarantined person must have a negative test result for dancer to return to dance.
